1. Know why the Bible is like a library and how a Bible reference works (book, chapter, verse).		
2. Know what the word “gospel” means and the names of key Bible books (first/last OT & NT, four Gospels, shortest book).		
3. Be able to outline the story of Mary Jones and how it led to the creation of the Bible Society.		
4. Know at least three reasons why the Bible is still important for Christians today.		
5. Know what the word “disciple” means and be able to list the 12 disciples		
6. Know who the first disciples were, how they were related, their job, and where Jesus called them.		
7. Know key facts about the disciples (who collected taxes, who was Andrew’s brother, Sons of Thunder, who betrayed Jesus, who doubted, “disciple Jesus loved”).		
8. Be able to outline the work of The Leprosy Mission with five clear points.		
9. Be able to write a simple modern version of the Good Samaritan story (hero, victim, two who ignored).		
10. Know who the patron saint of Ireland is and what St Patrick brought to Ireland.		
11. Know when and where St Patrick lived (birthplace, century, approximate year).		
12. Know key events in St Patrick’s life (kidnapping, slavery, escape, return to Britain, becoming a priest, return to Ireland).		
13. Know how St Patrick spread Christianity and which symbol he used to teach the Trinity.		
14. Know what the Reformation was, when it happened, and who started it (Martin Luther).		
15. Know the key beliefs of the Reformation (indulgences, Bible language, salvation by faith, authority of Scripture) and what happened to Luther, plus names of Protestant churches formed afterwards.
