

REVISION CHECKLIST FOR ART

In Art the KS3 Winter Examination consists of a practical drawing test for each Year Group based on a set theme. In Year 9 the theme is **'Footwear.'** You will be asked to bring in an item of footwear (examples include shoe, trainer, boot, wellington, football boot). You will set this up and draw it in a way that shows you understand the basic elements of drawing as follows:

- Composition
- Proportion
- Line
- Tone
- Texture
- Form

Your teacher will explain these in class and show some examples in the week before your drawing exam; however, you can research these terms in advance and you can also practice drawing the item you intend to bring in. At the end of your drawing exam you should write a short evaluation of what you have done, preferably using some of the terms above (this is worth 5% of your marks for the test). **Please note that your drawing exam will take place during one of your normal timetabled Art classes in the week before your other exams are being held.**

The drawing exam will make up half your marks for your tracking grade in Art. The other half will be based on the work you have done during the term from Sept – Dec.
