SCHOOL UNIFORM – KS4 (YEARS 11-12) and KS5 (YEARS 13-14)

BOYS

CORRECT SCHOOL UNIFORM IS COMPULSORY AT ALL TIMES

- Dark green blazer with official school crest on top pocket.
- Plain white shirt, long or short sleeved, tucked in with the top button fastened.
- School tie with House Badge, worn neatly to the waist.
- V Necked pullover with school colour insert (optional).
- Black school trousers.
- Black shoes – conventional school style i.e. plain or brogue style. Steel tips are not permitted. Black laces only. Boots/trainers are not acceptable. No canvas or trainer type shoes permitted. Official school shoes must be worn for the full academic year.
- Black or dark grey socks which cover the ankle (“invisible” socks are not permitted).
- The official black and red CHGS ¼ zip top may be worn as an additional item to and from school and at officially approved events. No other sweatshirts, hoodies or similar are to be worn at any time. Sweatshirts must not be worn inside school unless specifically designated by the Principal.
- One item of outdoor uniform. Outdoor coats must be plain black and free of logos or other writing. **No other form of outdoor jacket will be permitted.** Coats must be removed when indoors and stored in lockers, except in periods of very cold weather.
- Optional: Scarf – only official school scarf permitted. This may only be worn to and from school and not within the building.
- School bag (small logo only). Additional markings restricted to road safety flashes and owner’s name. No graffiti permitted.

Home Economics apron (available from Home Economics department).

FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM MUST BE WORN WHEN TRAVELLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL.

JEWELLERY:

- One pair of plain ear studs, worn one on each lobe. No variation will be permitted.
- One ring.
- One watch.
- No other jewellery will be allowed while in school uniform (e.g. nose rings, nose studs, body studs, ear cuffs, neck chokers). Clear plastic nose retainers must be worn in place of nose studs.
- Lapel badges restricted to official school badges/recognised youth organisations e.g. Scouts, Boys’ Brigade, and one charity badge.

PERSONAL PRESENTATION:

- Boys should be clean-shaven.

HAIR STYLE:

- Hair style must be conservative and colouring must be natural.

Any deviation to these regulations will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and requests must be submitted by a parent in writing to the Principal.

GIRLS

CORRECT SCHOOL UNIFORM IS COMPULSORY AT ALL TIMES

- Dark green blazer with official school crest on top pocket.
- Dark green knee-length kick pleat skirt (Years 11-12) or long skirt (Years 13-14, to be worn 7 cm below the knee). No alteration to official uniform will be permitted.
- White blouse, long or short sleeved, tucked in with the top button fastened.
- School tie with House Badge, worn neatly to the waist.
- V Necked pullover with school colour insert (optional).
- Black tights (may be worn all year).
- Shoes: Traditional school style with flat heels. No canvas or trainer type shoes. Black laces only.
- The official black and red CHGS ¼ zip top may be worn as an additional item to and from school and at officially approved events. No other sweatshirts, hoodies or similar are to be worn at any time. Sweatshirts must not be worn inside school unless specifically designated by the Principal.
- One item of outdoor uniform. Outdoor coats must be plain black and free of logos or other writing. **No other form of outdoor jacket will be permitted.** Coats must be removed when indoors and stored in lockers, except in periods of very cold weather.
- Optional: Scarf – only official school scarf permitted. This may only be worn to and from school and not within the building.
- School bag (small logo only). Additional markings restricted to road safety flashes and owner's name. No graffiti permitted.

Home Economics apron (available from Home Economics department).

PERSONAL PRESENTATION:

- Subtle make-up is permitted at KS4 and 5.
- Clear, neutral tone or French nail polish is permitted. False nails are not permitted.

- Hair style must be conservative and colouring must be natural.

Any deviation to these regulations will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and requests must be submitted by a parent in writing to the Principal.

PE AND GAMES UNIFORM

Cambridge House Grammar School PE and Games uniform can only be purchased from the online shop: www.cambridgehouseshop.org.uk. Shop opening dates and times will be communicated through all normal School communication channels.

Only regulation PE/Games kit may be worn. Other sports wear is not acceptable in class or when representing the school. All pupils will be required to wear Cambridge House Grammar School Kit.

*Only CHGS sports leggings bought through the school shop are to be worn in PE/Games.

** Sports trainers must offer sufficient protection and support for the pupil's feet. We strongly recommend that these are purchased from a recognised sports retailer. Casual footwear, light plimsolls or footwear with flat soles and no ankle support are not acceptable.

Pupils going home after Games periods or after school practices are permitted to wear either **full school uniform, including blazer**, or **CHGS tracksuit bottoms/sports leggings and t-shirt/regulation quarter zip**, (but not a mixture of school uniform and Games/PE kit.).

If a pupil is representing the School on a team, **agreed CHGS apparel** must be worn. Members of teams may be required to or given the opportunity to purchase additional items of kit.

If pupils are involved in a sporting activity from the beginning of the school day they may only come to school in their full tracksuit if they have been given permission to do so by the Head of PE. If PE/Games kit is required to be worn during the day, tracksuit bottoms must be worn. Shorts, skorts and leggings are not permitted to be worn as an alternative.

If pupils are leaving for a sporting activity **during the day** they come into school in their uniform and they change at the following times:

- Leaving between break and lunch – change at break time;
- Leaving after lunch – change at lunch time.

If pupils return during the course of the school day they must change into full uniform unless they have the full CHGS tracksuit (quarter zip and black Canterbury stadium tracksuit bottoms).

We highly recommend that all items of PE and Games kit are clearly labelled with the owner's name.
